Earlier in the year, we held our AGM on Monday 9th May, and the minutes from that meeting can be found on our website.

During that meeting we welcomed 2 new members to the Grants committee: Dr Ayonrinde, Consultant paediatrician and Sarah Trezise-Hardinge, children's Physiotherapist.
